Appointment of Senior Fellow to the Guinn Center

LAS VEGAS, NV — The Kenny Guinn Center for Policy Priorities announces the appointment of Brian Davie as a Senior Fellow. Mr. Davie recently retired after 28 years of service with the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB), the nonpartisan staff arm of the Nevada Legislature. He served as a Senior and Principal Research Analyst with the Research Division, and spent the past 19 years managing the Las Vegas Office of LCB as its first Legislative Services Officer.

Mr. Davie has participated in every legislative session in Nevada since 1985. He has staffed numerous interim and standing legislative committees, producing research and reports on a variety of major public policy issues including reapportionment, public lands, and school safety. Mr. Davie received his Bachelor of Science degree from the United State Military Academy at West Point, New York, and obtained a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the University of Puget Sound in Tacoma, Washington.
