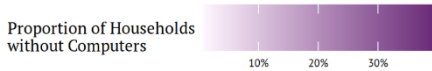
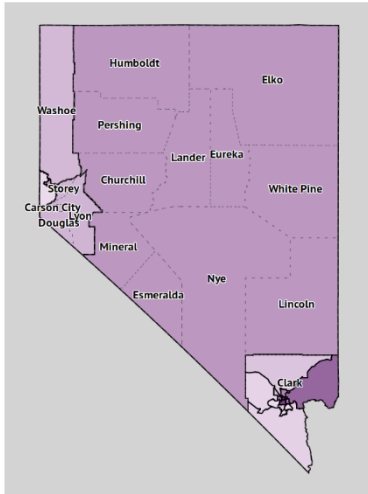


Nevada's Digital Divide

Proportion of Households in Nevada without Laptop/Desktop Computers

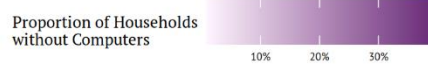
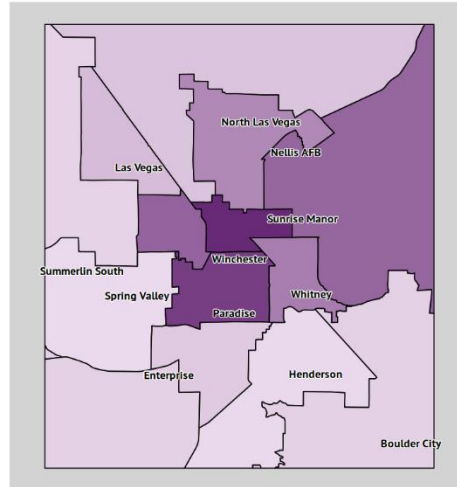
Households with Children Ages 6-17

Proportion of Households in the Las Vegas Metro Area without Laptop/Desktop Computers

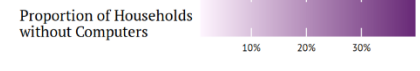
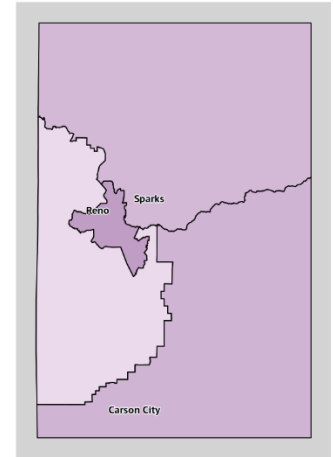
Households with Children Ages 6-17

Approximately 258,267 (24.0%) of **Nevada** households have children ages 6-17. Among these Nevada households:

- About 16.1% (or 41,692) do not have a laptop/desktop computer.
- Roughly 10.0% (or 25,916) lack Internet access.
- About 5.7% (or 14,829) have a smartphone as their sole computing device.
- Roughly 3.6% (or 9,264) have no computing device.
- About 7.0% (or 17,946) have a computing device, but no Internet access.
- Approximately 44.4% of households that lack a laptop/desktop computer also lack Internet access.
- And, 71.4% of households that lack Internet also lack a laptop/desktop computer.

Approximately 189,473 (24.7%) of **Clark County** households have children ages 6-17. Among these Clark County households:

- About 17.1% (or 32,351) do not have a laptop/ desktop computer.
- Roughly 11.1% (or 21,072) lack Internet access.
- About 6.2% (or 11,648) have a smartphone as their sole computing device.
- Approximately 4.0% (or 7,406) have no computing device.
- And 7.7% (or 14,622) have a computing device, but no Internet access.

Approximately 40,943 (23.1%) of **Washoe County** households have children ages 6-17. Among these Washoe County households:

- About 12.3% (or 5,029) do not have a laptop/ desktop computer.
- Roughly 6.8% (or 2,799) lack Internet access.
- About 4.5% (or 1,832) have a smartphone as their sole computing device.
- Approximately 2.1% (or 861) have no computing device.
- And 5.1% (or 2,096) have a computing device, but no Internet access.

In **rural Nevada**, approximately 27,851 (21.4%) of households have children ages 6-17. Among these households in rural Nevada:

- About 15.5% (or 4,312) do not have a laptop/ desktop computer.
- Roughly 7.3% (or 2,045) lack Internet access.
- About 4.8% (or 1,349) have a smartphone as their sole computing device.
- Approximately 3.6% (or 997) have no computing device.
- And 4.4% (or 1,228) have a computing device, but no Internet access.
